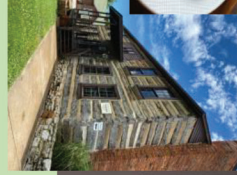

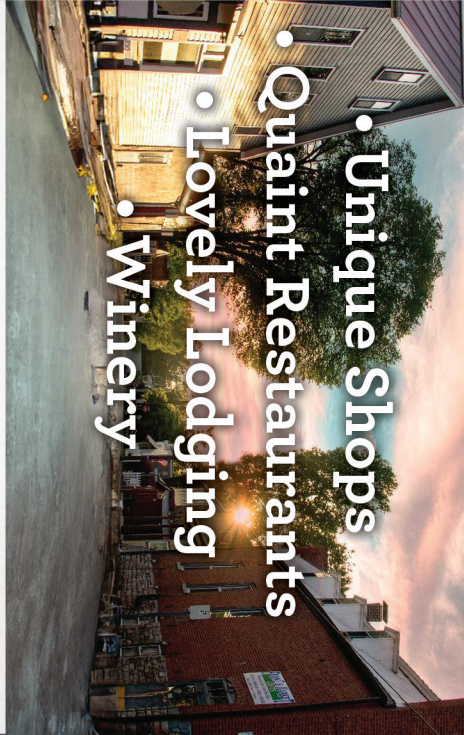

WHB. Windsor Harbor Road Bridge

Now on the National Register, is the oldest wrought iron span in Missouri. It once spanned the River des Peres in Carondelet. This bridge crossing the Rock Creek, just south of town, has been a part of Kimmswick since 1930.
